TRAVEL

From the M180 eastbound at junction 5, take the 4th exit on the roundabout on the A18 following signs to Humberside airport. Continue along the A18 for 4km until Great Limber village. Cars and mini-buses continue to the next junction and turn left. After 1km turn left, (TA141099), then follow signs along the forest road to the parking area at side of forest road.

COACH TRAVEL

Those travelling by coach will be dropped at the bus stop for their walk through to the assembly area. An official will meet you. There are no road crossings on the way in. The coach can then be parked in the village in J.W.Joyce's yard. Those bringing a coach must contact **Brian Slater** for instructions.

SAFETY

Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.

NEWCOMERS

Newcomers are always welcome at HALO events. Bring a compass and ask at registration for assistance.

REGISTRATION

YBT registration is by team, and in advance, to: - **Neil Harvatt** (<u>neil@halo-orienteering.org.uk</u>) Accompanying adults etc. may enter in advance with their team if they wish. Please would Team Managers visit Registration on their arrival to confirm that: -(a) - they are present and; (b) - to pay for their team (if not already done by bank transfer). Team Managers should collect any hired dibbers on behalf of their team.

EOD - for all others registration is from 10am to 11am. last start 11.20am

STARTS

The start is 200m from assembly and the finish is in the assembly field.

There will be a separate block of time allocated to Yvette Baker Trophy Final from 11.30am to 12.45pm. The YBT start times will be displayed at the Start and at Registration. Competitors can proceed directly to the start for their allocated start times. Call up will be at "-3".

It will **NOT** be a punching start for YBT competitors. Please do not be late! Late competitors will need to report to the Late Official. There may be a long delay before a vacant slot is available.

Other competitors will have starts from 10.30am to 11.20am.

Loose descriptions (waterproofed), and the 'White course maps' will be issued in the (-2) prestart lanes. Descriptions will be printed on the map. White & Yellow will have text descriptions.

MAP AND TERRAIN NOTES

The area consists of mixed woodland but mainly deciduous with a good ride & path/track network. The woodland is very runnable.

On-going forestry works (thinning) up until the date of the event are not expected to have any significant effect on runnability and may improve visibility. Brown features such as earthwalls, earthbanks, knolls, are small; gullies, pits and depressions are generally shallow. Most knolls are eroded rootstocks and therefore some knolls may appear like rootstocks and some rootstocks may appear like knolls. Some marked tracks are grassy rides and are periodically used for vehicles. Because of autumn leaf fall, and recent forestry works, some of the paths/tracks/rides may be less distinct than usual.


Please note the special control description for **horse jump** (**O**); and the standard **rootstock** (**X in a O**). Also note that rootstocks are mapped as **green crosses**, distinct trees as **green circles** and horse jumps as **black I's**.

Yellow and White course competitors please note that **boundaries of open areas are distinct** and you will be expected to use the forest edge as a line feature.

1:10000 scale. 5m contours.

Maps will be pre-marked on 'Pretex' waterproof paper and printed by 'Print5'.

The log-piles that are dotted around the area (and are unmapped) must not be climbed as they are very dangerous – pleased do not touch them under any circumstances.



CLUB TENTS

An area beside the run-in is allocated.

TOILETS

3 Loos have been ordered and will be located in the assembly area.

MAZE

This will be available for you to do in assembly. If there is sufficient interest then an "Unofficial" YBT club results will be organised from the individual results and published on the HALO website. This is for fun only.

If you have hired a 'dibber' then you will need to hang onto it to use on the Maze, however you must not download Maze results on the main system. A portable 'training' printer will be used to record times taken.

OUT OF BOUNDS

All woodland is OOB except whilst competing. Competitors arriving by coach should not deviate from the marked route to assembly as this passes through the competition area. The forest either side of the track used for vehicular access and car parking is also competition area and therefore OOB. Anyone seen transgressing, runs the risk of disqualification.

PRIZE GIVING

1st, 2nd and 3rd team prizes will be awarded at 2.15pm or a.s.a.p. after that time. Trophies need to be delivered to: - Brian Slater before the day; or registration on the day.
