<p><b>Parking</b></p>	<p>The council's car park on Tower Street on the East side of the River Hull is our choice for the event and costs <b>£1 for the day. You will need coins for the machine.</b> Note: this car park is separated from the River Hull by an Armco road crash barrier. <b>If you have young children, consider parking on the inland side of the car park (close to the Premier Inn Hotel) or in the overflow car park, which is close to the Finish.</b> An overflow car park may be needed and costs £2 for up to 4 hours. This overflow car-park does not have a height barrier and therefore is usable by motor-homes and other tall vehicles. The overflow car park is close by. After passing under the Castle Street dual carriageway on route to 'The Deep' turn left at the first roundabout (The main car parks for The Deep are on the right). This car parking is located close to the Finish.</p> <p>For ease of navigation, follow the signs for <b>'The Deep'</b> to access the car parking. The Tower Street Car Park is across from a tall 'Premier Inn', the event centre. You may park elsewhere if you wish but please do not park on residential roads in the Victoria Dock Village.</p> <p>The following is a link to the Hull City Council car parking areas in the City Centre, see <b>Tower Street. <p><b>Registration</b></p> <p>10.00 – 12:00</p>	<p>Meeting Room 3, Premier Inn, Hull City Centre, Tower Street, Hull, East Riding of Yorkshire, HU9 1TQ. The meeting room is on the 7<sup>th</sup> floor. Take the lift – the entrance is on the West side of the building. There is a restaurant, bar and toilets (bear right and right again around the bar). Meeting room 3 is to the left and forward as you exit the lift.</p>	
<p><b>Courses</b></p>	<p>Points scored will be attributed to <b>YHOA Urban League</b> as well as <b>UKUL</b>.          The optimum distance run could be 30% longer for courses A to F</p>

<p>Course B</p>	<p>Open Women (W18-W35) Veteran Men (M40+)</p>	<p>7.8km 30 controls</p>
<p>Course C</p>	<p>Veteran Women (W40+) Super Veteran Men (M55+)</p>	<p>6.4km 27 controls</p>
<p>Course D</p>	<p>Super Veteran Women (W55+) Ultra Veteran Men (M65+)</p>	<p>5.5km 27 controls</p>
<p>Course E</p>	<p>Ultra Veteran Women (W65+)</p>	<p>4.0km 22 controls</p>
<p>Course F</p>	<p>Junior Men (M16-) Junior Women (W16-)</p>	<p>3.7km 19 controls</p>
<p>Course G</p>	<p>Young Junior Men (M12-) Young Junior Women (W12-)</p>	<p>1.0km 9 controls</p>
<p><b>Starts</b></p>	<p>The Start is across the footbridge from the north end of the Tower Street Car Park, 100 m from parking. Start times 10:30 to 13:00. The course closing time is 14:30. Please start sufficiently early if you are concerned about having enough time to complete your course.          These will be published on Fabian4 – Wednesday mid-day.</p>
