Course Distance Suitability

<i>White</i>	<i>0.9km</i>	<i>Navigation by paths, roads, streets and fences for those new to orienteering. Minor road crossings.</i>
<i>Yellow</i>	<i>1.5km</i>	<i>Navigation by paths, streets and fences but with more difficult decision making required, for those who would like to walk/run a little further. Minor road crossings.</i>
<i>Technical Urban</i>	<i>2.8km</i>	<i>Navigation using some 'line features' but needing to find more difficult 'control' sites. A more challenging course for more experienced map readers. Road crossings</i>
<i>Technical Urban</i>	<i>4.8km</i>	<i>A technical course for those with some experience of orienteering – some control sites will be off-paths and in the wooded areas. Road crossings.</i>
<i>Long Technical Urban</i>	<i>7.6km</i>	<i>A longer technical course for those with lots of experience of orienteering. For optimum distance add at least 40%. Road crossings. Large capacity SI card required.</i>

The shorter courses cross no more than 2 estate roads.

Parents may accompany children on any of these courses.

Under 16s must be accompanied on Technical courses.

You may attempt as many courses as you wish in the allotted time.

Electronic timing will be used.

No pens or compasses required.

Courses close at 1pm
