Location & Parking	Grid Reference SE956065 This could not be easier! 100 metres North from Junction 4 of the M180 Turn left onto forest road through gate in Lay-by (just before the Portakabin Café), then follow forest road, west to parking area. Be aware of runners crossing this track. Parking will be on grass verge at side of forest road.																								
Yvette Baker Trophy	The Yvette Baker Trophy is the Premier Junior Inter-Club Competition in the country. Team Managers should ensure that their Juniors are eligible for the course they run. (YBT courses are Yellow, Orange, Light Green and Green). See HALO web-site for course eligibility rules. All YBT competitors should ensure they inform Registration that they are competing in the Trophy																								
Terrain	The area consists of mixed woodland with a good path & ride network. Much of the woodland is very runnable.																								
Registration and facilities	Registration will be at Scout Hut (approx 500m from Parking Area) from 10am to 12 Noon Toilets available adjacent Registration Cakes on sale on behalf of YHOA Juniors in the Registration Hut - please support

Entries	Entry on the Day only. £7 adults, £3 juniors. SI Electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire (£1 adults/50p juniors). Lost hired SI cards will be charged at £30.																								
Starts	10:30am to 12:30am Courses close at 2:30pm A Punching Start will be used. Control Descriptions will be available in the Start Lanes for all courses except White. (White course maps will be handed out at Registration) Yvette Baker competitors from the same club on the same course must ensure they start at least 4 minutes apart. Start and finish will be within a short walk of the Registration Hut. See link on HALO web-site for Assembly Area plan
