Humberside and Lincolnshire Orienteers invite you to the:-  
**Beverley Westwood Regional Event (level C)**  
**(Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> December 2019)**

**FINAL DETAILS** (4/12/19) are set in bold red text, within this original flyer.

- TRAVEL** From the West A1079 to Beverley Race Course.  
Grid ref. TA014397 200m West of HU17 8QZ (The Grandstand)
- REGISTRATION** 10:00 am to 12 noon.  
Parking is on hard surface in the Race Course Grounds.  
There is a gate which opens automatically when your car nears the gate.  
Registration will be in the Owners & Trainers facility building, enter from the car park.  
At registration – ‘dib’ to register.
- STARTS** 10:30 to 12:30. Courses close at 2:30pm  
Starts and finishes will be no more than 200 metres from the car park.  
This will involve one (busy) road crossing with a short walk on open grassland.  
Juniors should be accompanied.
- FACILITIES** There are outdoor and indoor toilets, the outdoor ones are convenient for those who have muddy footwear.
- OVERNIGHT ACCOMMODATION** For those of you who might wish to participate in both events, and reduce your carbon footprint, the ‘Race Course’ officials are offering a bed for £25 per person on the night of 14<sup>th</sup> December. The single and twin rooms are newly re-furnished. There are male and female toilets and showers plus a communal room for making drinks (kettle) and heating food (microwave).  
**Telephone Jasmine Burns on 01482 867488 to book a room/s** giving at least 48 hours notice so that rooms can be prepared.  
There are 6 single and 4 twin rooms only in the Race Course Lodge.

## NOTES

**White and Yellow have a taped section in Burton Bushes**  
**Orange and Light Green have a 1 minute timed out road crossing with controls on both sides of the crossing - this will be marshalled for Under 16s**  
**There will be one Start - 100 metres from Registration**  
**However there will be two Finishes :**

**Finish 1 : All courses except Short Green;**  
**100 m from Registration:**  
**Finish 2 : Short Green;**  
**800 m from Registration**

**There will be a marshalled road (40mph max limit) crossing from Registration to Start and from Finish to Registration. Please use this to keep safe.**

## TERRAIN

Beverley Westwood is a large area of predominately open common pastureland with three wooded areas, two of which are former quarried areas containing many contour features. The area is very popular with the public and also contains an 18-hole golf course. Please do not cross the greens. Please give way to the golfers and their balls. The courses will be planned to allow runners to cross the fairways diagonally rather than at right angles. The White and Yellow courses will not be in the area of the golf course.

## MAP

Please **email B Slater to reserve a map**, there will be some extras for late deciders. 1:7,500 scale. 5m contours. A4 size.  
Maps will be pre-marked on waterproof paper.  
The line of a golf fairways is shown on the map with a black arrow.  
The greens for each hole are permanently bounded by a wire fence.  
Note that the trees lining the roads on the Westwood are not shown on the map.
