From West A180 take the first turning for Immingham and Killinghome.
From South A18 go Brocklesby, Harborough.
Grid ref. TA188147 Worsley Rd., off Pelham rd. DN40 1DS nearest postcode.
Parking is on hard surface East off Worsley Road.

STARTS

10:30 to 12:30. Participants select a start time on the HALO website when registering.
Starts: –
2 separate lanes (A, C, E, F and G) (B and D) at the NE of the car park.
A start list is on the HALO website.
Sign in through HERO and click on 'Entry list'
or look on HALO front page (list imminent).
Visual countdown on the display clock – no beeps.
To check your SIAC is enabled, wave over the 'SIAC TEST' box after dibbing the
'CHECK' box.

FINISH

Download is at the Bert Boyden centre carpark approximately 50 m from the finish.
RESULTS will be live on the HALO website and hopefully we will provide a
print-out at download weather dependent.

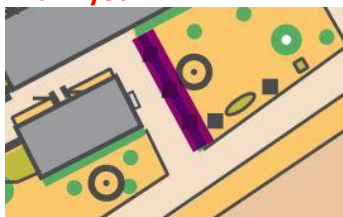

TERRAIN

This area is new to the regional fixtures but has been tested locally. It comprises the town centre, parkland and complex housing estates.

There are playing fields to cross so, if wet, good gripping footwear is recommended.

Course F does not cross the main road (Pelham Rd 30mph limit).

Negotiating narrow passages needs care especially on entrance and exit.
