Swinemoor Night Event (level C)

a YHOA Night League Event.

- TRAVEL** The event will be signed from the A1035/A1174 roundabout (TA043409) to the East of Beverley. Approach from this direction only, it avoids turning right across a busy road. Car Park (TA046403), Colonial House, next to Vauxhall which is on the left approx 780 metres SE of the roundabout along the A1174. The nearest post code is HU17 0LJ. Look for the large 'O' sign on the left.
- REGISTRATION** 4:30pm to 5:30pm The registration tent will be in Car Park.
- STARTS** 5:00pm to 6:00pm Courses close at 8:00pm
Starts and finishes will be within 250m of the parking area.
- ENTRY FEES** Seniors £6.00 Juniors/Students £3.00
£2 extra for adult non-BOF members
e-punch hire £1.00
Under-16s must be accompanied by an adult and will be non-competitive.
- COURSES** Night: 3 courses: Short, Medium and Long
- OFFICIALS** Organiser – Ken Hutson; Planner - Paul Simmons; Controller - Brian Slater.
- TERRAIN** Swinemoor Pastures is a fast open area with few line features which are mainly ditches. There are copses of hawthorn and a few form lines showing the lie of the land.
The area is bounded to the east by the River Hull and it is bisected N-S by the Barmston Drain which is un-crossable apart from at the marked crossing points. To the East of the drain the land is partly wet and marshy, only the longer courses will visit this area.
The land is grazed by horses, keeping the grass short and fast.
At this time of year (December) there are likely to be numerous areas of standing water which have been mapped but can vary depending on recent rainfall. Cross any waters with care, some are deeper than others.
- MAP** 1:7,500 scale. 5m contours. A map upgrade was done for the 2013 event. A4 maps will be pre-marked on waterproof paper.
- FACILITIES** No toilets - please use any available on your way to event. (Beverley Town Centre).
- SAFETY** Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. The Night event is intended for the experienced orienteer.
