



Terrain	An area of mainly deciduous woodland on well drained chalk slopes and open parkland/pasture land. A variety of contour detail and good runnability.		
Map	1:10000, 5m contours. Re-surveyed 2016 after extensive forestry work. Maps will be printed on waterproof paper.		
Entries	SI Electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire (£1). Lost hired SI cards will be charged at £30. Online entries (strongly advised) through Fabian4 (www.fabian4.co.uk) from 5 th October. Online entry closes on Wednesday 25 th October midnight. Postal entries on British Orienteering entry form (last post mark 25 th October), cheques to HALO c/o B Slater, organiser– contact details below.
