Orienteering is a challenging outdoor adventure sport that exercises both the mind and the body. The aim is to navigate in sequence between control points marked on a unique orienteering map and decide the best route to complete the course in the quickest time. It does not matter how young, old or fit you are, as you can run, walk or jog the course and progress at your own pace.

Poacher Series: -

A series of 11 weekly Spring/Early Summer Local Orienteering Events on Wednesday evenings open to all.

Courses

Yellow – this course is designed for those new to orienteering (instruction is given) - 1.5 to 2km - easy

Short – for experienced younger participants and those with experience who prefer a shorter distance - 2.5 to 3.2km – technically difficult

Long – for experienced orienteers with a reasonable level of fitness - 4.5 to 6km – technically difficult & physical

Participation

All are welcome to join in – however newcomers will be offered the yellow course only. Instruction will be given by experienced HALO members. Competence will need to be shown by individuals who wish to progress to the more difficult courses.

We have British Orienteering **Coaches** within the Humber area who can arrange sessions for improvers - please ask.

There will be a surcharge of £1 for hire of 'dibbers' which are essential for the electronic timing that is used. HALO members have free access to these for the duration of the series. Local family membership is £8 per year.
