(Assembly in the Market Square)

on Sunday 26th June 2011

TRAVEL and PARKING	The Assembly area is adjacent to the Market Cross in the "Saturday Market" in the centre of Beverley (TA 033 397). Parking is in any of the town centre car parks (these are free on Sundays). SAT NAV for Assembly is (N 53 50 35; W 00 25 49)
REGISTRATION	10am to 12 noon.
STARTS	Starts and finishes will be within the Assembly area. 10:30am to 12:30 Courses close at 2:30pm
ENTRY FEES	Enter on line at www.fabian4.co.uk (until June 23) Seniors £7.00 (£5 with BOF member discount) Juniors/Students £3.00 e-punch hire £1.00 (Juniors 50p) Entry on the day (and after June 19 online) add £2 for adults. Entry fees have been kept low due to competitor expense on toilets (see below)
COURSES	A -- 6 ½ km approx (M Open; M40+) B -- 5 ¼ km approx (W Open; W40+; M55+) C -- 4 km approx (W55+; M70+; W70+) D -- 2 ½ km approx (M16-; W16-) Competitors can enter any course, but to be competitive in the 2011 YHOA Urban League, they must enter the applicable course for their age group. M/W 16 and under will only be allowed on Course D for safety reasons. Parents should be aware that even this course will cross roads with light traffic. M/W16's will only be allowed to run up if they have passed their sixteenth birthday on the day of the race.

TERRAIN	Courses A to C will take place, in and around Beverley Town Centre consisting of roads, alleyways, pedestrianised areas and open spaces. The courses will visit many of this pleasant market town's attractions including The Minster. Course D will take place in the pedestrianised area and quiet streets adjacent to the town centre.
MAP	2010 map with minor updates 1:4,000 scale (tbc) Maps will be pre-marked and bagged.
TOILETS	There are attended toilets within 200 metres of Assembly (20p). Note: As there has not been the expense of hiring Portaloos, the event entry fee has been reduced to £5 (originally planned to be £6) – if you make less than five visits to the attended toilets you will be in profit!
SAFETY	Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. All competitors should carry a whistle. All competitors should be aware that Beverley centre has busy roads which will be crossed throughout the courses. Competitors are advised to take extreme care at all road crossings.
NEWCOMERS	Newcomers are always welcome at HALO events. Bring a compass and ask at registration for assistance.
