

Top orienteer

A BEVERLEY youngster steamed his way over the finish line in his first race in this year's East Yorkshire Short Race Orienteering Series.

England Junior Zac Field was just 28 seconds ahead of second placed Adam Bradbury from Rotherham in the closest competition yet for the series.

The race, which was organised by Humberside and Lincolnshire Orienteers (HALO) and was held at the Londesborough Park Estate. The event consisted of two 5km races, with a handicapped start calculated for the second race.

Zac won the Men's Open event. The Women's Open event was

won by Helena Crutchley from Skidby.

The next three rounds of the series will take place at Beverley Westwood on May 21, Driffeld Airfield on June 11 and at Hull University on July 23.

Beginners courses will also be available at each event for anyone wanting to try the sport.
