

Humberside and Lincolnshire Orienteers invite you to the **The Yvette Baker Trophy Final at Mausoleum Woods** (Sunday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2011) *This is a* **National Junior Competition** with courses for all.

TRAVEL	From the M180 eastbound at junction 5, take the 4 <sup>th</sup> exit on the roundabout on the A18 following signs to Humberside airport. Continue along the A18 for 4km until Great Limber village. Cars and mini-buses continue to the next junction and turn left. After 1km turn left, (TA141099), then follow signs along the forest road to the parking area at side of forest road.
COACH TRAVEL	Those travelling by coach will be dropped at the bus stop for their walk through to the assembly area. An official will meet you. There are no road crossings. The coach can then be parked in the village in J.W.Joyce's yard. Those bringing a coach must contact <b>Brian Slater</b> for instructions.
REGISTRATION	YBT registration is by team, and in advance, to <b>Neil Harvatt by 20th Nov</b> . Accompanying adults etc may enter in advance with their team if they wish. Entries on the day for all others from 10am.
PRIZE GIVING	1 <sup>st</sup> , 2 <sup>nd</sup> and 3 <sup>rd</sup> team prizes will be awarded at 1.45pm or a.s.a.p. after that time. Trophies need to be delivered to: - Brian Slater before the day; or registration on the day.
STARTS	The <b>s</b> tart is 200m from assembly and the finish is in the assembly field. There will be a separate block of time allocated to the YBT event. Participants other than those in the Trophy event 10.30am to 11.20am. Yvette Baker Trophy 11.30am to 12.45pm if required.
FEES	Seniors £7 (£5 BOF members) Juniors £2.50 <i>e-punch</i> hire £1.00
COURSES	White, Yellow to Blue
TERRAIN	The area consists of mixed woodland with a good ride & path network. The woodland is very runnable. Final details will include more details re the map and terrain.

SAFETY	Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. Final details will explain any other issues of which competitors need to be aware
