# Normanby Hall Regional Event

<b>TRAVEL</b>	The entrance to the Country Park is at SE887168, in the village of Normanby approx 6km north of Scunthorpe. It is well signed with brown tourist information signs. Parking will be in a level field (£1 per car)
<b>REGISTRATION</b>	10am to 12 noon. Registration will be in one of the Park's Classrooms.
<b>STARTS</b>	Starts and finishes will be within 500m of the parking area. 10:30am to 12:30am      Courses close at 2:30pm
<b>ENTRY FEES</b>	Entry on the Day only. Seniors £5.00      Juniors/Students £2.00 <i>Electronic timing will be in use (e-punch hire £1.00)</i>  <b>School groups are asked to email the organiser with approximate group size.</b>
<b>COURSES</b>	White to Blue School competitors will need to enter the appropriate course for their year group – further details will be provided.

<b>TERRAIN</b>	The area consists of the Normanby Hall Country Park with parkland and mixed woodland. The longer courses will visit the adjacent Community Woodland which has a variety of cover, including:- mature trees; areas of new plantations in different stages of growth; fast open and rough open areas. Some intricate point features.
<b>MAP</b>	1:7,500 scale. 5m contours. Recently updated. Maps will be pre-marked on waterproof paper.
<b>SAFETY</b>	Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.
<b>NEWCOMERS</b>	Newcomers are always welcome at HALO events. Ask at registration for assistance.
