| TRAVEL | <p>The entrance to the Country Park is at SE887168, in the village of Normanby approx 6km north of Scunthorpe. (Postcode DN15 9HU)</p> <p>The park is well sign posted from the Humber Bridge and M181 with brown tourist information signs.</p> <p>Parking will be in a level field (£1 per car)</p> |
| ENTRY and FEES | <p>Entry is on the Day only. Seniors £5.00 Juniors/Students £2.00</p> <p><i>Electronic timing will be in use</i> (e-punch hire - £1.00, free for schools competitors)</p> <p>School groups are asked to email the organiser (fixtures@halo-orienteeing.org.uk) with approximate group size.</p> <p>All children entered should be able to read an orienteeing map competently and be confident in using basic navigational techniques and should have competed in a previous orienteeing event. (Contact Organiser if clarification required)</p> |
| REGISTRATION | <p>10am to 12 noon. Registration will be in one of the Park's Classrooms.</p> |
| STARTS | <p>Starts and finishes will be within 500m of the parking area. 10:30am to 12:30am Courses close at 2:30pm</p> |
| COURSES | <p>White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Green and Blue</p> <p>School competitors will need to enter the appropriate course for their year group – see website or email organiser for details.</p> |

| TERRAIN | <p>The area consists of the Normanby Hall Country Park with parkland and mixed woodland. The longer courses will visit the adjacent Community Woodland which has a variety of cover, including mature trees; areas of new plantations in different stages of growth; fast open and rough open areas. Some intricate point features.</p> |
| MAP | <p>1:7,500 scale. 5m contours. Recently updated. Maps will be pre-marked on waterproof paper.</p> |
