Regional Event and Round 4 of 2013 YHOA Superleague

Location & Parking	The event will be signposted from the A64 Malton to Scarborough road. Turn south off the road, 10 km east of Malton, at Grid Ref SE 878753. Parking will be approx. 2.5 km along this track at Wolds Way Caravan Park (Charge £1 per vehicle).		
Terrain	Two areas of mixed woodland on well drained chalk slopes joined together by a short strip of farmland. Both areas feature a variety of contour details with generally good runnability.		
Map	1:10000 (Green – Black), 1:7,500 (White – Short Green), 5m contours. Survey 2006, minor updates 2013. Maps will be printed on waterproof paper.		
Entries	SI Electronic punching will be used at this event. SI cards (dibbers) will be available for hire (£1). Lost hired SI cards will be charged at £30. Online pre-entries (preferred) through Fabian4 (www.fabian4.co.uk) – revised closing date midnight 2nd April 2013. Entry on the day will be available subject to map availability.		
Courses	Courses available from White to Black (excluding Long Orange) To gain points in the Superleague, competitors need to enter the correct course for their age class.
